Frank Kaufmann is the director of the Inter Religious Federation for World Peace (IRFWP) (originally a Unification Church ecumenical organization).^[1] He served as editor in chief of the IRFWP's academic journal *Dialogue and Alliance* from 1998 until 2009, during which time, in 2004 was named as one of the top ten religion journals (out of 650) by an independent panel commissioned by the American Theological Library Association (ATLA)^[2]

In 2007, Kaufmann was nominated for Hofstra University's first Guru Nanak Interfaith Prize.^[3]

Expanding his purview, Kaufmann announced himself as the Founder and President of Filial Projects in 2011.^[4]
